Dear Parents,

We hope you all had a great Easter break and that everyone is now feeling refreshed and ready for the start of the Summer Term! We are really looking forward to all the exciting new learning opportunities in Year 1/2 this term, including our school visit to the Black Country Living Museum!

Along with this letter you will find an overview of this term's learning. It would be most helpful if you could share this information with your child.

In History we will be exploring the Victorian era; thinking about what the Victorians have done for us. This will also involve a school trip (a separate letter informs this)

Later in the term in Geography we will be learning all about the Seaside. Here we will be exploring a seaside resort and making comparisons to the local area of Tewkesbury. Please feel free to share on Dojo any information that you have at home on any of this term's areas of work that you are happy for your child to share with the class (History this half term and Geography the next.) Thank you.

P.E. will mainly be taught on the following days for each class:

Robin: **Tuesday** and **Wednesday**

Nightingale: **Wednesday** and **Friday**

Swallow: **Thursday** and **Friday**

Please ensure that your child comes to school wearing their PE kit on these days. The P.E. kit should include a pair of correctly fitting daps and shorts. In colder months, children may wish to wear jogging bottoms.

Outdoor Learning

Outdoor learning sessions will take place each week, children need to wear long sleeved tops, long trousers and suitable footwear (trainers or wellies) Please could they also bring a waterproof coat. If sessions are in the morning, could children please come in their kits and school uniform to change into. For afternoon sessions, could children please bring kits in bags to change into.

Every Monday, we will send out the spellings for the week so that children can practise these at home and Year 2 can be ready for their Friday quiz.

We would like to see Reading Diaries completed so that we can support you and your child with their home reading journey. Children can change their home reading books as often as needed.

We are sure that you will continue to support your child's learning by listening to them read as often as possible. Please comment on **ANY** type of reading your child has done at home.
